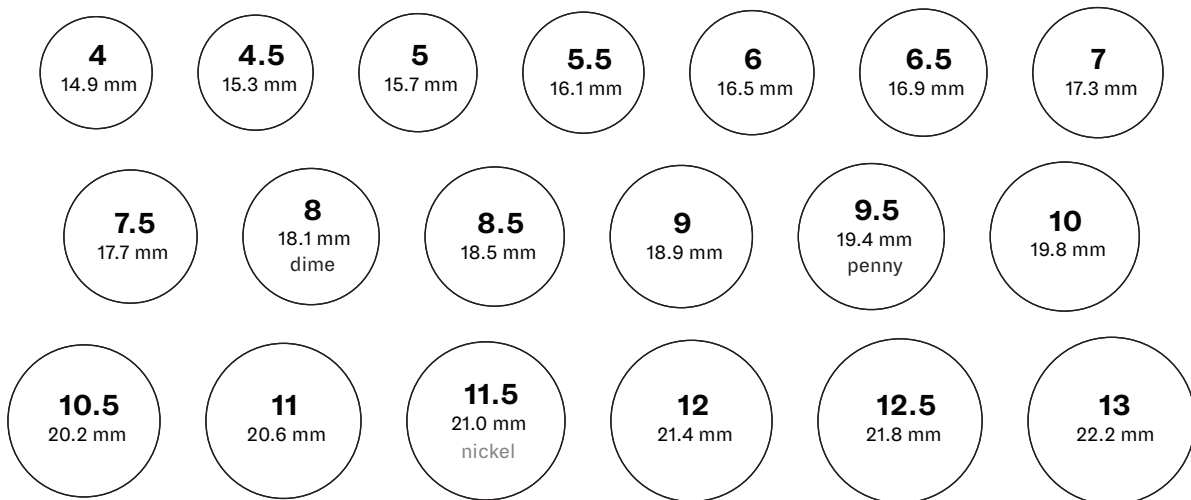


HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- Before measuring your ring size, be sure this guide is printed in US Letter size and scaled to 100%.
- You can check the accuracy of your print by positioning a credit card on the line below or placing the correct coin in one of the labeled ring sizes. If the card or coin lines up, you're all set.

OPTION 1 MEASURE A CURRENT RING

1. Choose a ring that correctly fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for. In the united states the engagement ring and wedding band are most commonly worn on the "ring finger" of the left hand.
2. Lay the ring over each of the size circles below, until you are able to closely match the inside edge of the ring to one of the circles on the guide.
3. If the ring falls between two of the sizes, order the quarter size in the middle.



OPTION 2 CREATE YOUR OWN RING SIZER

1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
2. Wrap the ring sizer snugly around the widest part of the intended finger so that the numbers are visible to you, and insert the pointed end through the slit you made in the sizer.
3. Make note of the number that lines up with the slit, this is your ring size! Keep in mind that quarter sizes are also available if your sizer indicates that you are between whole and half sizes.
